Respondent Independent Counsel's Response to Appellant's Re-Filing of Appeal on Behalf of Mr. Prince Taylor with Application for the Appeal to Be Filed Out of Time

1. Respondent Independent Counsel ("Respondent") takes no position regarding Appellant Prince Taylor's non-compliance with the Rules of Procedure and Evidence of the Special Court for Sierra Leone and the Practice Direction for Certain Appeals Before the Special Court (2004) as set forth in the Appeals Chamber's Judgment in Contempt Proceedings. Respondent takes no position, moreover, regarding how the Appeals Chamber should treat Appellant Prince Taylor's Re-Filing of Appeal on Behalf of Mr. Prince Taylor with Application for the Appeal to Be Filed Out of Time. Respondent does, however, direct the Appeals Chamber to a contempt-of-court appeal judgement by its sister tribunal, the International Criminal Tribunal for the Former Yugoslavia, which states that it is an "imperative norm of international law" that "[e]veryone convicted of a crime shall have the right to have his conviction and sentence reviewed by a higher tribunal according to law."
