

I Honourable Justice Vivian M. Solomon, sitting as Designated Judge pursuant to the President's 'Order for Detention and Transfer and for Hearing Pursuant to Article 12(F) of the Practice Direction on Conditional Early Release of Persons Convicted by the Special Court for Sierra Leone' dated 9 March 2016;¹

RECALLING the Decision on the Defence Oral Application to Release Moinina Fofana from the Custody of the Residual Special Court for Sierra Leone pending the Disposition of the Matter of Alleged Violations of the Terms of his Conditional Early Release ("Decision"), filed on 21 March 2016;

NOTING that the title on Page One of the Decision erroneously makes reference to "Allieu Kondewa" as a party to the matter;

PURSUANT to Rule 54(B) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence of the Residual Special Court for Sierra Leone,

HEREBY ORDERS that the title on Page One of the Decision be amended to delete reference to "Allieu Kondewa" who is not a party to the matter.
