JUSTICE RENATE WINTER, PRESIDENT OF THE RESIDUAL SPECIAL COURT FOR SIERRA LEONE (“Residual Special Court”)

SEIZED OF Allieu Musa Kondewa’s (“Kondewa”) Petition by Convicted Person to Establish Eligibility for Conditional Early Release filed on 22 September 2016 pursuant to Article 2 and Article 3 of the Practice Direction on the Conditional Early Release of Persons Convicted by the Special Court for Sierra Leone as revised on 2 December 2016 (“Application” and “Practice Direction” respectively);

CONSIDERING the finding in the President’s Decision on Allieu Kondewa’s Eligibility for Consideration for Conditional Early Release dated 2 December 2016 (“Decision”) that Kondewa is eligible for consideration for conditional early release;

NOTING the Order to the Registrar in the Decision to *inter alia*, provide the information required under Articles 5(C) to 5 (H) of the Practice Direction no later than 30 days from the date of the Decision, i.e. on or before 2 January 2017;

SEIZED of the Submission of the Registrar Pursuant to Rule 33(B) for a Request for Extension of Time to Comply with the Registrar’s Obligations as Provided in the Decision on Allieu Kondewa’s Eligibility for Consideration for Conditional Early Release dated 6 December 2016, seeking an extension of time to comply with the Order until 30 January 2017;

SATISFIED that an extension of time is necessary to enable the Registrar to obtain and collate the volume and amount of information required pursuant to Articles 5 (C) to 5 (H) of the Practice Direction;

GRANTS the request for extension of time and **ORDERS** that the Registrar shall submit the information required under Articles 5 (C) to 5 (H) of the Practice Direction not later than 30 January 2017.
