## THE PRESIDENT OF THE RESIDUAL SPECIAL COURT FOR SIERRA LEONE ("Residual Special Court")

**RECALLING** The Motion "Prosecutor Against Charles Ghankay Taylor - Taylor's Request for Temporary Transfer to a Safe Third Country to Continue His Imprisonment Due to Massive Outbreak of COVID-19 in the UK";<sup>1</sup>

**NOTING** the "Prosecutor's Motion for Leave to Respond to Taylor's Request for Temporary Transfer to a Safe Third Country to Continue His Imprisonment Due to Massive Outbreak of COVID-19 in the UK";2

CONSIDERING Article 23(3) of the Statute of the Residual Special Court for Sierra Leone ("Statute") which provides *inter alia* that the Residual Special Court shall have power to supervise the enforcement of sentences, including implementation of sentence enforcement agreements;

**CONSIDERING** further Article 13(3) of the Statute and Rule 28 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence ("Rules") which authorize the President, in exceptional circumstances, to designate an additional duty judge from the roster to exercise judicial functions;

**COGNISANT** of the need to ensure expeditious proceedings before the Residual Special Court;

**HEREBY** Designates Justice Teresa Doherty, to hear and determine all matters arising from the Motion;

ORDERS that the designated Judge shall exercise her functions remotely unless the President decides otherwise for good reason.
